Sealed bids for a single contract for sanitary sewer, spot curb and sidewalk removal, sawcutting and base course will be received by the Village of Cambridge, Wisconsin until February 8, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. local time, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter in the Village meeting room.

The contract consists of the following approximate quantities:

8-inch Sanitary Sewer Replacement	1,500 lineal feet
48-inch Sanitary Sewer Manholes	70 vertical feet
Sawcutting	3,500 lineal feet
